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Funds were made available to Alaska Department of Fish and Game by the Yukon River River Panel's Restoration and Enhancement (R&E) Fund to support the implementation of the Panel's 2003/04 R&E program and review of 2004 conceptual and detailed R&E project proposals.

The Technical Contact (Ms. McNeil) reviewed all conceptual and detailed R&E project proposals for technical merit. In addition, ongoing communication was maintained with all 2003 project contractors to monitor the delivery of these projects, and to review and approve progress and final reports for each project. Effective communication was maintained with the Panel's Secretariat throughout the 2003/04 fiscal year with regard to the conduct of current-year projects and the review of 2004 conceptual and project proposals. Assistance was provided to 2003 project contractors in the preparation of their 2003 project reports; and with project proponents in their preparation of 2004 project proposals.

A consultant was contracted to review all U.S. and Canadian 2004 detailed project proposals. The consultant worked with the Technical Contact to assess the technical merit and economy of the detailed R&E project proposals. This review involved assessment of all R&E proposals pertaining to feasibility, appropriateness, completeness, focus, and statistical soundness based on the R&E Fund criteria and priorities.

This project was contracted in the amount of \$30,000US, of which \$20,000 was expended, with \$10,000 being de-committed.
